## QPR Training for Suicide Prevention

Did you know that each day 122 people die in the U.S. by suicide? Unfortunately, because of stigma and fears surrounding suicide, it is rarely spoken about. Through QPR Training, the Bucks County Suicide Prevention Task Force has set out to end that stigma and educate teens and their parents in the hopes of preventing such tragedies. QPR, which stands for Question, Persuade, Refer, is a free, 2-hour training that helps teens and their parents/guardians to understand and recognize a mental health crisis. By learning QPR, you will come to recognize the warning signs, clues, and suicidal communications of people in trouble and gain the skills to act vigorously to prevent a possible tragedy. The more people trained - the more lives saved. Registration is required for this program.
