

UPDATE ON SOUTH WELLS AND VOLATILE ORGANIC COMPOUNDS (VOC).

South Well # 2 located in the Estates of Doylestown remains off and is not pumping water into the distribution system. Even though South Well # 2 is off, we continue to monitor for VOC's. The most recent sampling for VOC's took place on June 4th, 2010. The results became known on June 29rd, 2010. Tetrachloroethylene (PCE) was found at 0.0054 mg/L or 5.4 parts per billion (ppb). A second VOC sample was taken at South Well # 2 on June 17th, 2010. Results for that sample became known on June 30th, 2010. PCE was found at 4.0ppb. The maximum contaminant level (MCL) for PCE is 5ppb.

The 3 other water wells in the surrounding area were sampled for VOC's at the same time as South Well #2. South Well # 1 (located behind Sears) had a result for PCE at 2.9ppb, well within the allowable limits for PCE. South Wells # 6 & # 7 sample results for PCE were no-detect.

Monthly sampling will continue at South # 2 while treatment options are being explored. South Well # 2 will remain off.
