By choosing to be a Doylestown Township Adopt-A-Road Sponsor organization you are agreeing to the following:

1. Your group will participate in a safety training session at Doylestown Township.
2. Your group will pick up and utilize the safety gear provided by Doylestown Township (vests, signs, etc.)
3. Your group will clean a one mile section of road four times per year.
4. Your group will notify staff of the dates when you will be doing a cleanup. You will be provided with safety signs for posting on the road the day of the cleanup. The township will also collect the trash bags that you leave for them on the roadside. If your cleanup is on a weekend, the bags will be collected on the following Monday. If you would like to dispose of the trash yourselves, you may. No clean ups may be done without five days notice to the Township.
5. Children must be 8 years of age to participate in the cleanup program. We require a 1 to 4 ratio of adults to children.
6. All clean ups should be done between the hours of 8 am and 3 pm to avoid unsafe conditions at dawn and dusk.

They are: Almshouse Road, Lower State Road, Edison-Furlong Road, Pebble Hill Road (Sugar Bottom to Boro), Swamp Road/Route 313 Old Dublin Pike, Ferry Road, Pine Run Road, Limekiln Road (Boro to Pine Run), Sandy Ridge Road (West to Route 202), Bristol Road and Sugar Bottom Road.
