

ORDINANCE NO. 376

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF DOYLESTOWN, BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 119, PARKS AND RECREATION AREAS, ARTICLE I, CONDUCT IN PARKS, §119-9, FIREARMS; HUNTING; FIREWORKS BY AMENDING THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION A. AS HEREINAFTER SET FORTH

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Doylestown Township, by the adoption of the Doylestown Township Code has promulgated various rules and regulations related to the Township's Park and Recreation areas; and

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has adopted House Bill No. 80 of 2013, which said statute places limitations on Municipalities as to their powers and prerogatives related to firearms; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to amend its Codes and Ordinances so as to comply with the provisions of Act 80.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED and ENACTED as follows:

1. The provisions of the Doylestown Township Code at Chapter 119, Parks and Recreation Areas, Article I, Conduct in Parks, §119-9, Firearms; Hunting; Fireworks; Subsection A. is herein repealed in its entirety and in lieu thereof, the following is provided:

§119.9 Other than an officer of the law, no person shall discharge a firearm, rifle or other weapon within the park system.

2. In all other respects, the provisions of the Doylestown Township Code are reaffirmed and ratified, subject only to the modifications of same as set forth herein.

3. In the event any court of competent jurisdiction shall declare any portion of this Ordinance invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the Ordinance in its entirety as it was the intent


of the Board of Supervisors that the Ordinance would have been adopted even had the offending provision not been included.


4. This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days after enactment.


