

**DECLARATION OF SNOW EMERGENCY**

**January 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2016**

WHEREAS, on January 22<sup>nd</sup> 2016 a winter storm threatens to cause injury, damage, and suffering to the persons and property of Doylestown Township; and

WHEREAS, the winter storm may endanger the health, safety and welfare of a substantial number of persons residing in Doylestown Township; and


WHEREAS, emergency management measures are required to reduce the severity of this pending winter storm and to protect the health, safety and welfare of affected residents in Doylestown Township:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, the undersigned Chairman of the Board of Supervisors of Doylestown Township and Director of Public Safety, do hereby proclaim the existence of a snow emergency in Doylestown Township


FURTHER, I direct the Doylestown Township Emergency Management Coordinator and staff to coordinate the activities of the emergency response, to take all appropriate action needed to alleviate the effects of this winter storm, to aid in the restoration of essential public services, and to take any other emergency response action deemed necessary to respond to this snow emergency.

“No Parking” restrictions will be in effect for the designated Snow Emergency Routes, and these roads are also restricted to vehicles with four wheel drive or snow chains. Vehicles left parked on these designated Emergency Snow Routes are subject to towing if the owners cannot be located. On the non-snow emergency routes residents are asked to voluntarily remove cars from the streets when possible to facilitate more effective road and parking lane clearing

This Declaration shall take effect immediately.
