

## **Public Announcement from DTMA**

Please be advised that on May 19, 2016 the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) lowered the health advisory level for Perfluorinated Compounds (PFC's), which is an unregulated contaminant. A constituent known as PFOA of this compound was found in the Cross Keys well. This contaminant was found at a level exceeding the newly posted lower level of .07ppb. Therefore, the Doylestown Township Municipal Authority (DTMA) made the decision to shut down and take off line the Cross Keys Well. Water is being provided to the area through a secondary source. Various treatment options are being explored at this time. Updates will be posted as they become available.

The Doylestown Township Municipal Authority (DTMA) Cross Keys Well remains off line. At this time, the DTMA has decided a new source of supply would better meet the needs of the Cross Keys water system and its customers.
