202 / **Doylestown to New Hope** The Bucks County Planning Commission and the Bucks County Bike Taskforce are working on this item. There was some discussion as to whether or not there would be adequate access. There may be problems in accessing certain areas along Route 202.

Mr. Kelso indicated that he flagged a portion of the proposed trail from the Parkway through the College to the Chalfont / New Britain Sewage Treatment Plant,. He spoke with John Schmidt and also wants to talk to the College, it was suggested that we contact Art Glass. Mrs. Goldman indicated that she would like to see the College participate more in the committee meetings.
