**Neshaminy Greenway Trail DVRPC**

Still awaiting the final paper work from DVRPC; did modify Phase I and Phase II has been submitted. We met with the County Open Space Program and asked to be able to use Open Space funds, we also proposed the idea to the Doylestown Township Board of Supervisor and they're of consensus to allow us to use the County Open Space funds for construction of the path. We will work up a budget but we estimate approximately \$200,000 needed for construction of the Neshaminy Greenway. We do have easements which will be part of Phase II with the cemetery and New Britain Township has reviewed.

**DCNR Grant Opportunities**

It was suggested that we start design for Phase of the Peace Valle that is due in March. See if we can get Mr. Stanford to pull some numbers together and being to reach out as well to New Britain Township. Federal Funding - Congress is looking to significantly cut funding, anyone who would like to reach out to any representatives of Congress it would be a good idea. It was also, recommendation to have Cold Spring meeting with the Doylestown Borough and Doylestown Township.

**Miscellaneous**

There was discussion on the Sensory Trail and how that lays out. It is being presented to the Board of Supervisors on February 21<sup>st</sup>. Mr. Kelso suggested calling Ron Bernstein at Behavioral Health to see, what if any support they may have for the project.
