

DOYLESTOWN TOWNSHIP PARK AND RECREATION BOARD

Meeting Notes: June 8<sup>th</sup>, 2015

The regular meeting of the Doylestown Township Park and Recreation Board was called to order at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, June 8<sup>th</sup>, 2015 at the Doylestown Township Administrative office.

In attendance: David Hansen, Deb McComas, Kathy Brown, Ada Popek. Caroline Brinker, Karen Sweeney and Barbara Lyons. Joining us for the first time was Janet Stavrides and Lois Wegfahrt.

Janet and Lois both described their interest and enthusiasm in the Doylestown Dog Park and why they were eager to become involved in our ongoing efforts to improve and maintain a first quality dog park in Doylestown.

Fannie Chapman and a dog sponsored swim party to conclude the summer 2015 season was the main topic of conversation. The *Fido Float at Fanny* seems to be a name everyone liked and felt appropriate for our party. Sept. 12<sup>th</sup> was selected as a possible date with a rain date on the 13<sup>th</sup>. In order to move this gathering forward we were asked to submit a proposal to the Fanny Chapman Pool Committee by June 22. Deb McComas volunteered to take charge of preparing the proposal submission. Discussions involved selection of different dog sizes (big vs. little) and specific times for each group to be in the main pool. Other considerations for rules and regulations for the day were also discussed.

Barkminister seem to be a big hit with ideas for a bigger and more expansive effort for 2016. Fund raising will be an area we need to focus on for next year. The raffle and contributions yielded a nice addition to our bank account. We agreed preparations for next year's Barkminister should begin in Jan. 2016.
