 Speed stats from July, August, October, and November 2013 do not exceed 20%. The Committee recommends that the Doylestown Township police collect speed stats closer to the resident's home on Sauerman Road. 	
 3. South Easton Road - New Britain and Sauerman Road intersections: Committee discussed the issues and options with Dave Tomko. The township police have collected current speed stats. The Committee reviewed the current speed stats and issued a response. A meeting with PA DOT occurred on 28-Mar., and the following plans were drawn up. 	Chief Logan / Dave Tomko
 4. Timing of the traffic light at the intersection of Upper State Road and Almshouse Road. Chief Logan contacted Dave Tomko and recommended that the township move forward with having the signal permit modified. 	Dave Tomko
