Thoughts include: a small concrete median to prevent using the center dual turn lane to bypass northbound traffic and queue for lefts on 7-11 or Edison-Furlong, don't block the box markings (recommended by DVRPC). Left turn from Duane onto southbound 611 is also dangerous. Accident stats should be pulled.</li> </ul>	Mark
