Review of last month's speed stats - determine if additional steps are warranted, note highlighting of those that exceed 20%: <i>[See attachment: to be distributed at meeting]</i> 2. Cherry Lane - speeding complaint Review of sight distance survey from Pennoni - the previously approved reduction of speed limit should address this. Data is OK - within bounds. Mr. Comber attended August meeting. A increased police presence has been recommended. Construction traffic from Pools Corner have been using it as a through road. Dave will contact PaDOT regarding this. Bulk of the construction will be done by the fall. 2nd web submission received from Mr. Kinyon. Offered using his yard for speed patrols. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Mr. Peluso attended October meeting. Added that there's a blind spot due to a slight rise near Dogwood Lane. Signage to flag this may be required.</li> <li>Motion by Mark, 2nd by Carol, to recommend that the Township Traffic Committee reduce the speed limit to 25 mph.
