Review of last month's speed stats - determine if additional steps are warranted, note highlighting of those that exceed 20%:  <i>[See attachment: to be distributed at meeting]</i></li> <li>2. Lower State Rd. - sight distance concerns from Terversall <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Updated speed readings are to be taken. The implications that it has, especially on a state owned road, were explained.. A representative from the community should contact the Chief in mid-January for the results.</li> <li>• Forward report to PA DOT, to make them aware of the sight distance concerns - to be authored by Chief Logan and Dave</li> <li>• PA DOT reported back last week.
