Following a lengthy discussion, on a motion by Mr. Borden and second by Ms. Hamilton, the P&R Board voted unanimously in favor of a one-year trial period with the condition that the PA State Fair representatives can adequately address and satisfy all reasonable concerns brought forth by the township.

<u>www.doylestownRec</u>: Ms. Sweeney reported that the department had made a lateral move to a new web based program that would allow for better outreach as well as online registration and credit card payment. Ms. Sweeney noted that while there are some limitations with the new program, the potential for additional community access was greatly improved. She noted there would be no additional increase in cost for the new system.
