



## DOYLESTOWN TOWNSHIP PARK AND RECREATION BOARD

Meeting Notes: September 9, 2014

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The regular meeting of the Doylestown Township Park and Recreation Board was called to order at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, August 12, 2014 at the Doylestown Township Administrative office.

### Meeting Notes - September 9, 2014

The meeting notes were unanimously approved on a motion by Ms. Suessenguth and second by Ms. Kelly

#### Visitors:

Mr. Salvati provided the P&R Board with a status report relative to the Kids Castle playground project including completion of the Mural Walkway and installation of the Pirate Ship.

#### Ongoing / Old Business

Kids Castle: Mr. Salvati provided an update on the Kids Castle renovation as well as the dedication of the new Pirate Ship..

Sensory Enrichment Trail: Ms. Sweeney provided a status update of the Sensory Trail project.

#### Site Visit - Central Park:

During the site visit to through Central Park the board made the following observations and suggestions. Follow up discussion was suggested for the next meeting.

#### Tennis Courts:

- Add replacement of lights to the Capital Plan
- Identify and resolve rust spot issues as soon as possible
- Add Pickle Ball lines on courts 1 and 2
- Consider the possibility of wind dividers between courts 2 and 3

#### Pavilion #1:

- Wear and tearing noticed on the drop sidewalls – monitor and plan for replacement
- Plan for concession stand renovation and contract concession sales.
- Replace water fountain outside pavilion due to hazardous sharp and rusty edges.

#### Environmental Education Area

- Two benches in hazardous disrepair – Replace as soon as possible
- Decking on the bridge is in need of repair.
- The sign near the bridge needs to be replaced

#### Woodland Trail:

- Concerns expressed about the potential for continued paving within the woodland area.

#### Dump Area:

- Concerns expressed that as the Upper end of the park opens to new activities, the dump area will be perceived as an eyesore and create potentially hazardous areas thus lessening the appeal of the park. Suggestions include a retaining wall, some type of screening, appropriate fencing, security measures providing for employee only access.

**Adjournment:** Being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 7:05 pm on a motion by Ms. Suessenguth, seconded by Ms. Brown
