Visitors:

Mr. Salvati provided the P&R Board with a status report relative to the Kids Castle playground project including completion of the Mural Walkway and installation of the Pirate Ship.

Plan Review

Thompson: Following discussion the Board agreed there was no viable recreation opportunities and recommended Fee In Lieu on a motion by Ms. Kelly, seconded by Mr. Salanik and unanimously approved.

Ongoing / Old Business

Sensory Enrichment Trail: Ms. Sweeney reported that actual trail construction had been completed. She further noted that a meeting was scheduled for August 18th with various professional experts to discuss individual “pod” equipment and function and developmental benefits for the intended user groups.

Golf Outing/Concerts: Ms. Sweeney gave reports on both events including financial updates relative to revenue generated.

Discussion:

Ms. Sweeney reported that some investigation was being done relative to possible renovation to the administrative offices and noted the plan may include a recreation building. Following discussion Mr. Bray noted that he was interested in requesting that the Board of Supervisors give consideration to including the amphitheater as part of the overall planning process.

Park Video: Ms. Rehmet presented her park video project for the Board’s review and approval. Following review and discussion the Board praised the video and thanked Ms. Rehmet for her hard work. By consensus, the Board approved the video pending the completion of edits requested.

Central Park Site Visit: Due to inclement weather, Mr. Bray suggested that Central Park be the next site visit in conjunction with the September 9th meeting and that it be done as a bicycle tour.
