

5. Keith Hass, Managing Director of DTMA provided an update on installation of public water in the Pebble Ridge and Wood Ridge neighborhood. Project scheduled to start the end of September on Stony Lane Circle and run 6-8 weeks.

6. Steve Hartman from Carroll Engineering gave an in-depth presentation with regards to updating the Doylestown Township Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act (Act 537). The 537 Plan is meant to help address existing sewage disposal needs, and to help prevent future problems through the proper planning, permitting, and design of sewage facilities. Two remaining sections of the Township without public sewer have been divided into two sections, Phase 2 and Phase 3, within the updated 537 Plan. Once completed the Plan will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors with a recommendation from the Public Water and Sewer Advisory Committee on how to proceed with future expansion of public sewers in Doylestown Township.

With no further business the meeting was ended. **The next meeting of the Public Water & Sewer Advisory Committee is October 15, 2020.**
