Mr. Glassman called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. A quorum was present and the following matters were discussed:

- 1. Minutes for meeting of 9/14 were approved.
- 2. Funding capital expenditures from fund balance can no longer be maintained
 - Core infrastructure costs are greater than core revenues, resulting in a decline in unrestricted fund balance
 - Historically, the Township had adequate fund balances to pay for capital expenditures as a result of the positive cumulative impact of higher revenues and lower operating costs during a period of significant housing and population growth
- 3. Discussion centered on options
 - What would be necessary for status quo per the projection
 - Potential cost saving measures (significant size required to minimize impact of expected budget shortfalls)
 - Service levels, capital expenditure needs, pension shortfall, headcount, salaries, benefits
 - Overall, need to clearly define the Township's objectives going forward as to service levels and operating guidelines
- 4. Expect 4 budget work sessions with the board starting Oct 7.
- 5. One more projection to be run before first work session. Ken to run one last pass.
 - Reconsider capital expenditures
 - Verify Park and Recreation costs vs. Dick's document numbers
- 6. Looking for board response and direction/guidance resulting from projections in the first work session
- 7. Stephanie asked for advice on energy source selection coming up.
- 8. Meeting adjourned at 8:50PM
