MINUTES APPROVAL

REPORTS

AUTHORITY ENGINEER'S REPORT

Mr. Ciottoni noted that the Central Booster Station and Neshaminy Manor Booster Station Emergency Generators Project is currently out to bid. Bids are due in October. He also provided an update on the recent PFAS meeting with CDM Smith, Inc., and indicated results of the preliminary water supply analysis should be ready in a few months.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

2023 Capital and Operations Budget Update

Mr. Hass reported that there was good feedback from the budget work session held earlier today. Mr. Van Houten stated that there will be no rate increase next year. Mrs. Lyons suggested that after the budget is approved putting in the newsletter that there will not be an increase. Mr. Van Houten directed Mr. Hass and Finance Director Mr. Wallace to review the DTMA investments to maximize returns. The earnings on these investments could be used to offset water main extension construction costs to future DTMA customers.

DEP Bucks County Drought Watch

Mr. Hass indicated Bucks County and DTMA are currently in a drought watch due to the dry conditions. DTMA and the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection is asking customers to reduce their water usage by 10%. Information on the drought has been posted on the DTMA website and Doylestown Township social media.

BCWSA Update

Mr. Hass stated Aqua put out a press release that the BCWSA sewer system transaction has been shelved.
