IV. Ed Ebenbach updated 2021 operations results. EIT has remained stable. Transfer taxes remain strong.

VII. Ed Ebenbach discussed progress re-spending the American Rescue Plan Funding.

VIII. Dave Tomko discussed the development of a plan to finance expedited road maintenance. One third of the township roads will be paved in ten years. Six miles were paved in 2021 for \$1.6 million per Sean Torpey. A rise in fuel costs makes road material fuel costs go up.

IX. Dave Tomko led a discussion re-the final status of 2021 Capital Projects for sewers and roads. Turk Road costs will be shared with Warrington Township. Kids Castle is wrapping up. Doylestown Township follows Penn Dot specs.
