

Sledding Safety Tips

Sledding can be a great way to enjoy winter weather. The joy of speeding down the hill makes it easy to forget that this activity can also lead to injuries. Taking a few safety measures can help keep you and your kids safe on the hills this winter.

- Avoid sledding in areas with trees, fences, and light poles or on rocky hills.
- Teach children to have an adult with them when they go sledding.
- Always go down the hill feet first.
- Learn how to stop and turn the sled by using your feet.
- Have only the recommended number of passengers on a sled at one time.
- Do not sled in the street or on a highway.
- Never ride a sled being pulled by a car, ATV, snowmobile, or other motorized vehicle.
- Avoid sledding on driveways, hills, or slopes that end in a street, drop off, parking lot, river, or pond.
- It is easier to see when you sled during the day. If you are going to sled at night, make sure the hill is well lit and that it is easy to see any potential hazards

QPR Training for Suicide Prevention

Did you know that each day 122 people die in the U.S. by suicide? Unfortunately, because of stigma and fears surrounding suicide, it is rarely

spoken about. Through QPR Training, the Bucks County Suicide Prevention Task Force has set out to end that stigma and educate teens and their parents in the hopes of preventing such tragedies. QPR, which stands for Question, Persuade, Refer, is a free, 2-hour training that helps teens and their parents/guardians to understand and recognize a mental health crisis. By learning QPR, you will come to recognize the warning signs, clues, and suicidal communications of people in trouble and gain the skills to act vigorously to prevent a possible tragedy. The more people trained - the more lives saved. Registration is required for this program.



Shared Use Trails

Understanding Shared-Use Trail Etiquette can make trails more enjoyable for everyone, it's important that you understand trail etiquette. Follow these steps:

Respect other users; expect other users. Show courtesy. Respect wildlife. Respect public & private property. Leave no trace.

Be friendly and courteous. Greet other folks with a simple "Hello!" or "Nice day today!"

Bicyclists should yield to everyone. Runners yield to walkers. Downhill traffic yield to uphill traffic. When in doubt, give other users the right of way.

Announce yourself when approaching others, especially from behind. If you're in a group, avoid blocking the trail.

Stay on the trail. Creating your own path or cutting switchbacks creates erosion, damages habitat and natural resources.

Operate within your ability at all times. Remember that situations can get out-of-control fast if you're not attentive!

Be considerate, keep dogs leashed and under control at all times. Other trail users don't know your dog is friendly.

Bring water, snacks, maps and other equipment you may need. Know where you're going, and tell someone else your plan.


