Welcome

Minutes Approval – March 17, 2026 – On motion of Ms. Jones, seconded by Ms. Hendrixson, the minutes were approved.

Pebble Hill Trail – Update

Ms. Mason indicated that the team walked the area on the Doylestown Country Club Property, laid out and marked trees that would need to be removed. We sent letters to the Country Club letting them know that this was done. Mr. Stanford will follow up with them. In addition, we also sent letters to some the property owners along Pebble Hill road and met with about four or five of them at that time as well, letting them know that the project continues to move forward. There was a question about volunteer opportunities, we will follow up with that going forward.

New Britain Road Trail Project – Update

Everything is done, just one tree that needs to be planted at Morgan Hill. Thinking of late May, possibly the 28th or 29th for the ribbon cutting in the late morning. We need to work on our photo collage for the site. We'll confirm shortly.

Safe Cycling for School Children – Update

Ms. McElroy was able to meet with Ms. Hernandez and Yvonne Custer, who is a big YouTube personality for kids. She is very excited about working with the Bike/Hike Committee and doing a video, she had a lot of great ideas. She could possibly work on the video at the end of May or June, and she could also incorporate the Pump Tract, get kids out to participate in the ideas making sure we can get the message about appropriate cycling and making it safe for kids. Also, something the Central Bucks School District P.E. teachers could use. Some suggestions, including bike etiquette, material we already have, connecting with Sgt. Courts and a discussion on the new E-Bike ordinance should be incorporated in any video.

Update County Trail Projects

Mr. Regosch indicated that they're finalizing the permitting by the end of May. It's been pushed a bit but they're hoping to get construction and bidding this summer or fall. Working with Mr. Tomko on the map Township map so that the information and data can all be pulled into the format we like with the County's information. The Goodman Properties for this particular trail is going to be in the road right of way so no issues with the Goodman Property.

Pump Track

Ms. Hernandez indicated that the work is being done, they expect an opening by June 1st. They used millings from the Township for assistance.

Prioritize List of Future Projects:

Proposed Trail at Pine Run

The Township reviewed the proposed MOU's, they are acceptable and we shared them with the solicitor's office, and they confirmed. They're being sent to the County and Pine Run.

Mr. Clarke would like copies of letters sent to the homeowners on Pebble Hill Road.

Ms. Dixon reminded everyone that spring is here, you have to give four feet for those riding on the road, bikes and walking. Make sure you are wearing appropriate reflective if you are riding at night. Kids should be wearing helmets.
