**Meeting Notes**

**Welcome**

Ms. Goldman welcomed everyone to the meeting.

**Minutes Approval – April 14, 2026** – On motion of Mr. James, seconded by Ms. Holewinski, the minutes were approved with one corrected typo changing reflexive to reflective in the last paragraph of page two. The minutes were unanimously approved.

**Pebble Hill Trail – Update**

Mr. Stanford indicated Doylestown Country Club (DCC) is moving forward, township staff will build the trail, applying for a HOP permit from PennDOT as well as E & S Control permit from the Conservation District should occur this fall. Follow up with DCC meeting of the layout, the construction of the bridge over the little creek by the Country Club will happen next year. Need DEP permits for hydrology and that will need to be put out to bid. Adjacent to the driving range there is about 150' with no fence, we will look at adding trees and fencing, we will need to coordinate with the Country Club.

It was indicated that there are some flags and activity at Cherry and Pebble Hill that is across from where we would have the trail. This is a private matter.

The Munshower Property is being sold, Mr. Kelso indicated that he met with them while we were out walking the easement, they do have concerns about the speed for the road. Ms. Mason indicated that letters have been sent so that future owners will be aware of the project.

**New Britain Road Trail Project – Update**

Ribbon Cutting will take place on May 29<sup>th</sup> at 11am at the New Britain Road Entrance to Central Park. Ms. Valmore agreed to work with the Telecommunications Advisory Board (TAB) on a video for the project.

**Safe Cycling for School Children – Update**

Ms. Goldman met with Ms. McElroy and Ms. Custer, who are very excited about working on the safe cycling for school children project. It was suggested that there be a meeting between TAB, Ms. McElroy, Ms. Custer and Sergeant Courts, who hosted the meeting earlier this year on safe cycling. A new joint video may be worth discussing.

**Update County Trail Projects**

Mr. Regosch indicated that the Neshaminy Greenway Phase I timeline for approvals are slated for the end of May, with reviews by the Commissioners occurring about the same time.

## **Pump Track**

Ms. Goldman indicated that the track is completed and grand re-opening is June 1<sup>st</sup>. In addition, wooden jumps have been added in the wooded areas.

## **Prioritize List of Future Projects:**

### **Proposed Trail at Pine Run**

Mr. Kelso indicated that he and Ms. Mason had a Zoom Call with the County, and they seem interested in the project. The County attorney needs to review the MOU further. It was suggested that this segment be added to the Circuit Program.

Ms. Mason and Mr. Kelso are working to set up a meeting the Executive Director at the Pine Run Village.

Ms. Jones indicated that if a connection through the Shrine to Peace Valley could be developed it would be a great connection.

### **Other Business**

Mr. James shared a photo of lots of bicycles parked at Kutz Elementary School and said how great it was to see children riding to school again. He observed the same at Doyle but not at Linden.
