

**TOWNSHIP OF DOYLESTOWN, BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
ORDINANCE NO. _____**

THE ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF DOYLESTOWN, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 153, SUBDIVISION AND LAND DEVELOPMENT, ARTICLE VI, DESIGN STANDARDS, SIGNS, WHICH SAID AMENDMENT IS TO THE SUBDIVISION AND LAND DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE THAT IS SET FORTH IN THE DOYLESTOWN TOWNSHIP CODE, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, the Doylestown Township Board of Supervisors, after careful review of its Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance and receipt of public comment, has concluded that it would be in the public interest to amend the provisions of the Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance as it relates to signs, as the sign regulations have been incorporated into the Doylestown Township Zoning Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED AND ENACTED that the Doylestown Township Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance, as set forth in the Doylestown Township Code, is amended as hereinafter provided.

Section 1. The provisions of Chapter 153, Subdivision and Land Development, Article VI, Design Standards, Section 153-44, is hereby deleted in its entirety from the Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance.

Section 2. In all other respects, the Codified Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance of Doylestown Township, as amended, is reaffirmed and ratified, subject only to the amendment to same as set forth herein.

Section 3. Should a section or provision of this Ordinance be declared invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance, as a whole or any part thereof, not declared invalid.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after enactment.
